






 - Rising 8 (Current 7) February 13 17 through Health and PE






Tips for Selecting Classes

- ★ Make an informed decision
 - Explore through the Curriculum Resources
 - Try a Strenghths Explorer or Career pathways activity through NAVIANCE Student in a future SEL lesson you will be able dive into the Academic and Career Planner Tool
 - Choose an appropriately rigorous schedule for next year. Budget time for homework, activities, sports, (& college applications!)
 - Seek advice from your support system
 - Current subject teacher expert of content and student's strengths in a particular area
 - Teacher of prospective class what to expect in class, time requirements, rigor
 - Counselor –graduation requirements, career/college planning, advising process
 - Coaches NCAA/VHSL Eligibility
