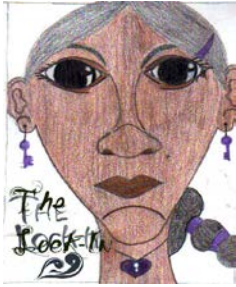

8th grade Summer Reading Project

Hayfield Secondary School

Due: September 6, 2019



Requirements:

Over the summer, read a work of FICTION. It should be at least 200 pages long and should NOT be a book that has been turned into a movie.

On one side of a large note card, paper, or medium-sized poster, write a one-paragraph *summary* of a book of your choice. Please do not use any outside sources to write your summary. Make sure it is in your own words. Include the following information:

- The title of the book (underlined) (The Mark of Athena)
- The name of the author (**Rick Riordan**)
- A summary of what happens in the book. You should include the major events from the **beginning**, **middle**, and **end** of the story and its major characters.

Write a second paragraph that *critiques* the book. Include the following information:

- 1-2 reasons why you either liked or disliked the book
- 1-2 reasons why you would or would not recommend the book to a friend
- One question you had after reading the book
- Any other comments you want to share about this book

On the other side of the paper, poster, or note card, draw a picture. This picture can be:

- An important scene from the book
- A character from the book
- An image inspired by the book, such as a fake book cover
- Below the picture, write a 1 -2 sentence caption explaining how the picture relates to the story.

Your drawing or image must be in colored pencil, crayon, marker, or colored ink.

Scoring Rubric:

You must include the following information on your project in order to receive full credit:

_____/10 points Summary of the book is accurate and includes all the listed information

_____/ 5 points Critique of the book includes the above information.

_____/ 5 points Paper is illustrated neatly reflecting a scene, character, or image inspired by the book. The picture is in color.

____/ **20 points**
