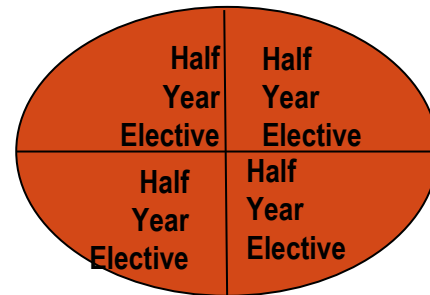
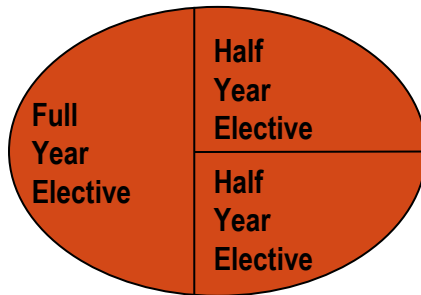
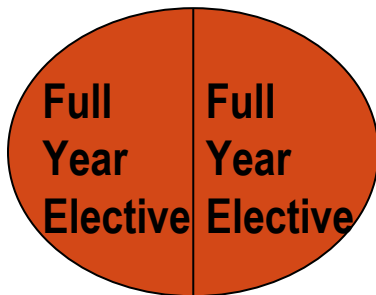


Required Courses at Hayfield



CLASSES

- 5 required classes:
 - English/English HN
 - US History/US History HN/Civics HN
 - Science/Science HN
 - Math/Math HN/Pre-Alg/Alg 1
 - Health & PE
- 2 periods of Electives:
 - 2 Year long electives - OR - 1 Year long elective and 2 half year electives - OR - 4 half year electives



How is Honors Different?

❖ Honors English, History or Science involve:

- ❖ More independent learning – in class work independently, more homework
- ❖ Extension assignment – learning the same information, but additional assignment to show depth of knowledge
- ❖ Higher level writing and analysis

❖ Honors Math 7 Involves:

- ❖ Math 7HN encompasses the Math 8 curriculum
- ❖ Students should demonstrate mastery of Math 7 content prior to enrolling in course
- ❖ Requires students to take Math 8 SOL
- ❖ FCPS guidance for students NOT in Advanced Math 6 wishing to complete Alg 1 in MS is to take Math 7 (7th) and Alg 1 (8th)

Rising 7th Academic Advising Timeline
