Quick Guide Sheet – College Process

For Transcript Requests:

1. Access the Transcript Request Form in [Student Services](#) section of Hayfield's website or in Schoology (**Courses → Student Services → Class of 2025**)
2. All transcript requests are FREE!
3. September-October 2024: Hand completed and signed transcript request form(s) to your school counselor
 - a. Oct 24-Jun 25: Hand completed and signed transcript request form to the Transcript Assistant up front in HS Student Services (down the attendance hall)
4. Return both pages of the Transcript Request Form to the School Counselor/Transcript Assistant at least 4 weeks before your earliest college deadline

Counselor Letter of Recommendation:

1. School Counselor Recommendation Questionnaire (**REQUIRED**; must be emailed or handed to your school counselor) - <https://tinyurl.com/3anuyzfa>
 - a. Be detailed as possible; please share what you would like your school counselor to focus on; the more we know about you, the better!
2. Parent Questionnaire Form (optional): <https://tinyurl.com/yc8cehsv>
3. You must ask your counselor to write a letter of recommendation; please do not assume submitting a questionnaire is asking; please review the college website to confirm whether they require a counselor letter of recommendation or not.
4. Questionnaire(s) must be submitted and request for a counselor letter made at least 4 weeks before the earliest college deadline.

Secondary School Report (SSR) & Document Uploads:

1. Counselors will use a standard form to upload—no need to print the Common App or College Site version.
2. Counselors or Transcript Assistant will upload all documents (e.g., transcripts, rec letters, SSRs, etc.) via the delivery type you select on the Transcript Request Form

SAT/ACT Scores:

1. Request official copies from College Board and/or ACT.
2. Take note of schools that are score optional or allow students to self-report.

IMPORTANT FAFSA INFO: Anyone who plans to attend college should submit a FAFSA at www.fafsa.gov (expected to launch in December 2024 for the 2024-2025 academic year). Many students believe they are not eligible for student aid and do not submit a FAFSA. This is a mistake. Here are some reasons why:

- ❖ The FAFSA is free and costs nothing to complete.
- ❖ The FAFSA is necessary for most forms of student aid.
- ❖ If your family's financial circumstances suddenly change, you'll already have a FAFSA on file.

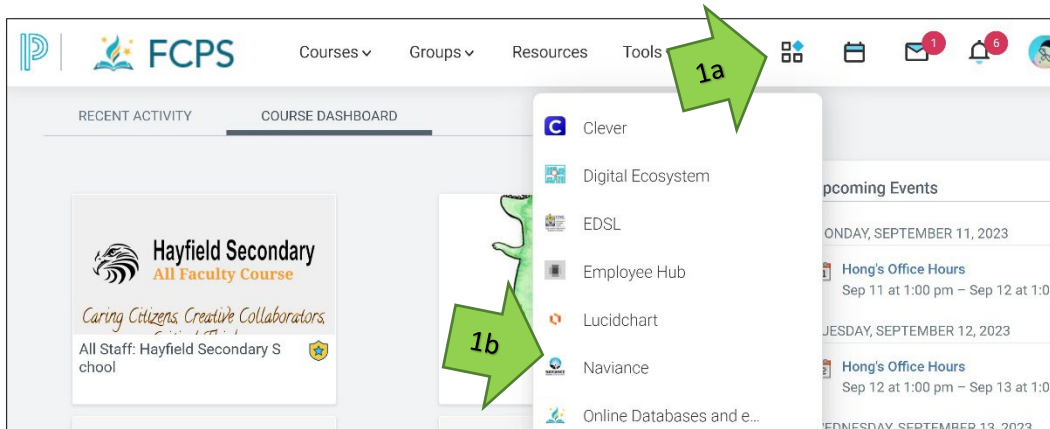

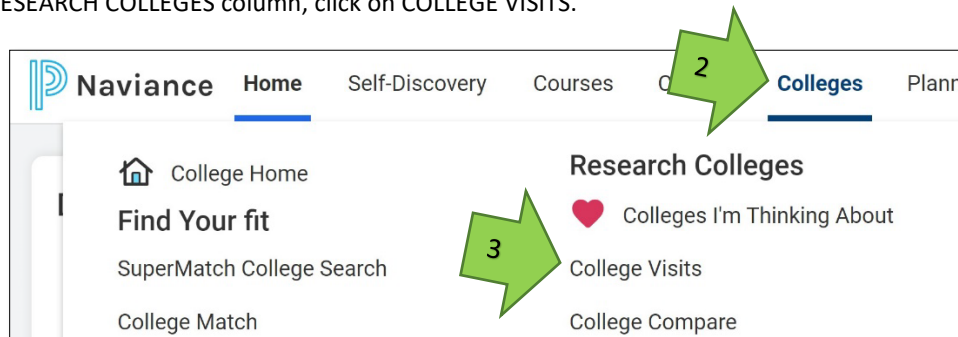

How to Register for a College Admissions Rep Visit in Naviance

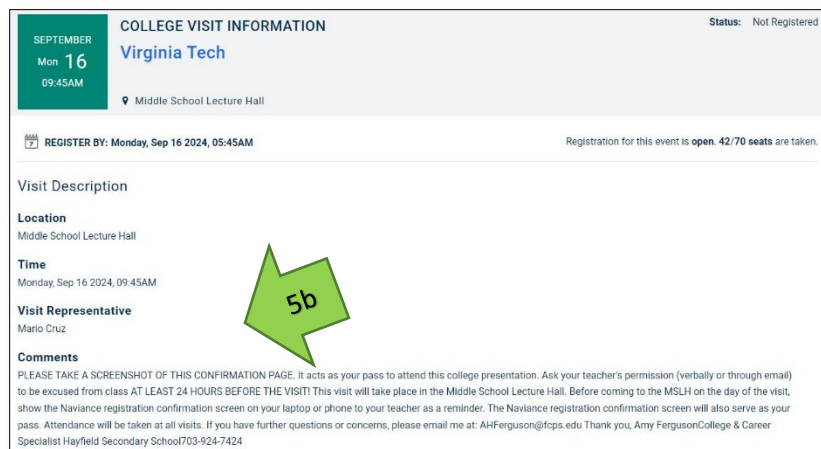
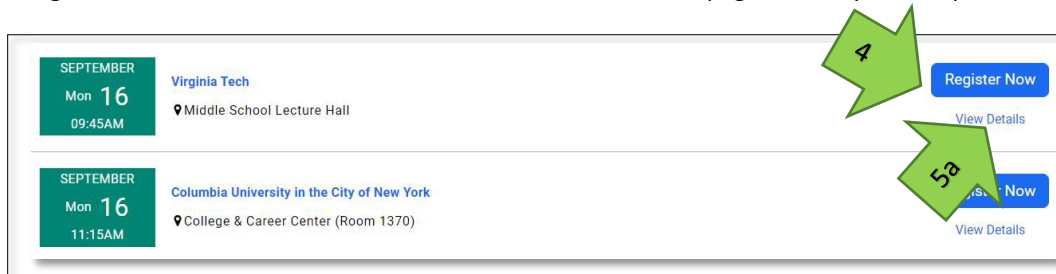
1. Log into your Schoology account, and on the top right, select NAVIANCE STUDENT. This brings you to the login screen for Naviance. Click "Student Naviance Login" and enter your FCPS username and password.



2. In Naviance, click on the COLLEGES tab at the top.
3. Under the RESEARCH COLLEGES column, click on COLLEGE VISITS.



4. Find the college presentation(s) you want to attend, then click REGISTER NOW.
5. After you register, click VIEW DETAILS. Take a screenshot of the DETAILS page—this is your hall pass to attend.

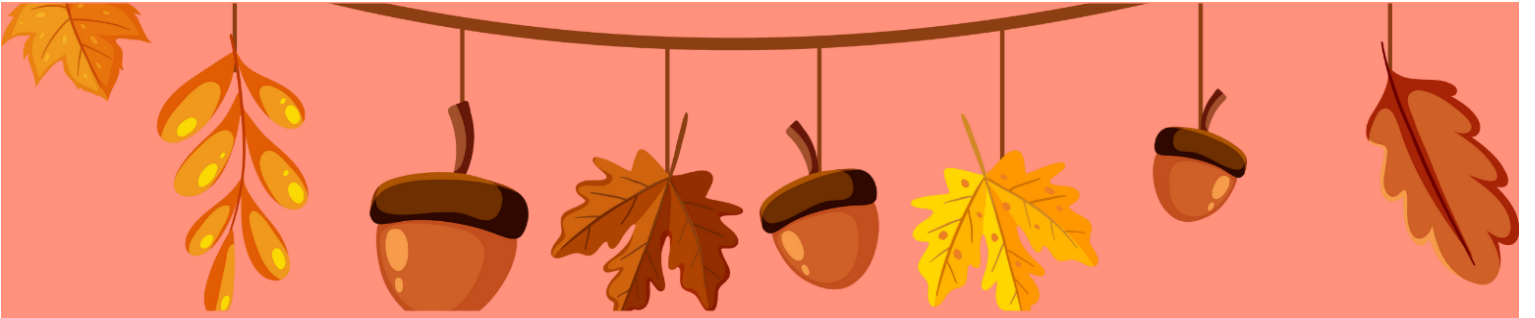

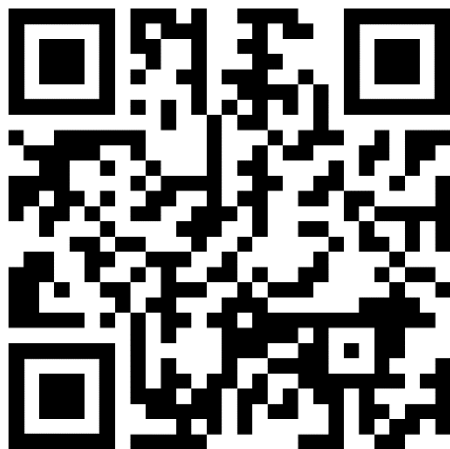

1. Print, complete entire form, and sign.
2. If you are under 18, a parent/guardian must also sign.
3. Till the Transcript Assistant transitions in, please submit the form(s) to your counselor **whenever you need a transcript**

School Counselor Recommendation Questionnaire:

1. Save a copy of this document, type your answers, and email the completed form to your counselor.
2. ***The Questionnaire AND Transcript Request Form must be submitted at least 4 weeks before the earliest college deadline.***
3. You must also officially ask your counselor via email to write a letter of recommendation (just submitting the Questionnaire does not constitute “asking” for a recommendation letter).
4. Please double-check the school site to ensure they require a counselor letter of recommendation.

Parent Questionnaire Form (“Brag” Sheet):

1. This is an optional form that can be turned into your counselor before a recommendation letter is written (recommended this is submitted with the Student Questionnaire and Transcript Request Form).

Important Notes – Please Read

- ❖ **Self-Reporting Grades (SRAR):** A transcript request **MUST** be submitted for each college application, even if you are self-reporting your classes and grades (e.g., VA Tech)
- ❖ **Test Scores:** Hayfield **DOES NOT** mail standardized test scores (SAT, ACT, TOEFL) to colleges. You must request them directly through College Board or ACT
- ❖ **Letter of Recommendation (Counselor):** You **MUST** submit a Counselor Recommendation Questionnaire **AND** request via email **AT LEAST 1 MONTH** before your college deadline (*chart on left*)
 - Questionnaire Link: <https://hayfieldss.fcps.edu/node/2183>
- ❖ **Letter of Recommendation (Teacher):** You are responsible for requesting teacher letters. These letters are **NOT** sent with your official transcript. Your teacher will submit their letter through Common App/other application portal upon your invitation.

If I have responded yes to the statement below, however, I have waived the right to review or have copies of any letters of recommendation written by FCPS employees.

If an application requires or requests a student’s social security number (SSN), FCPS staff members should not enter the SSN on the student’s behalf.

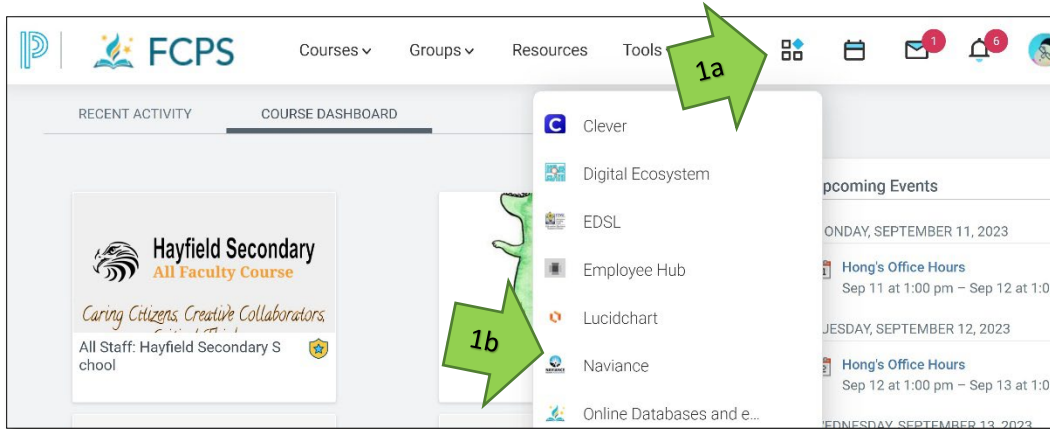

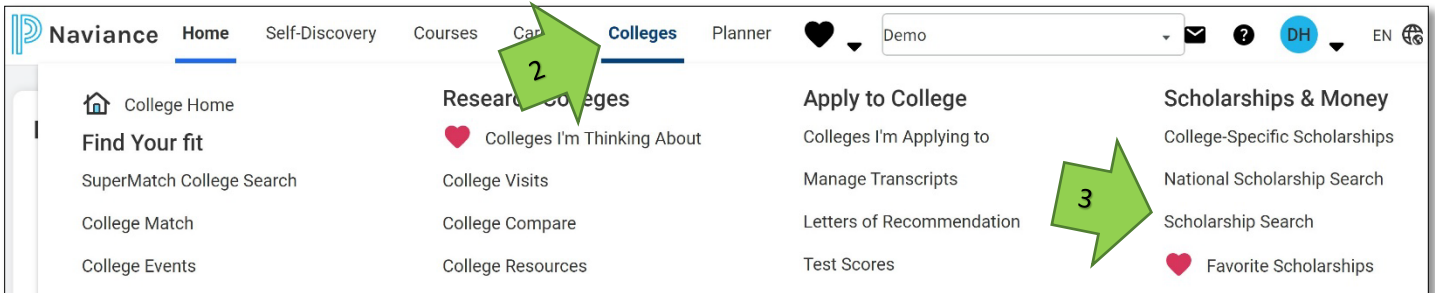

How to Search for Scholarships in Naviance

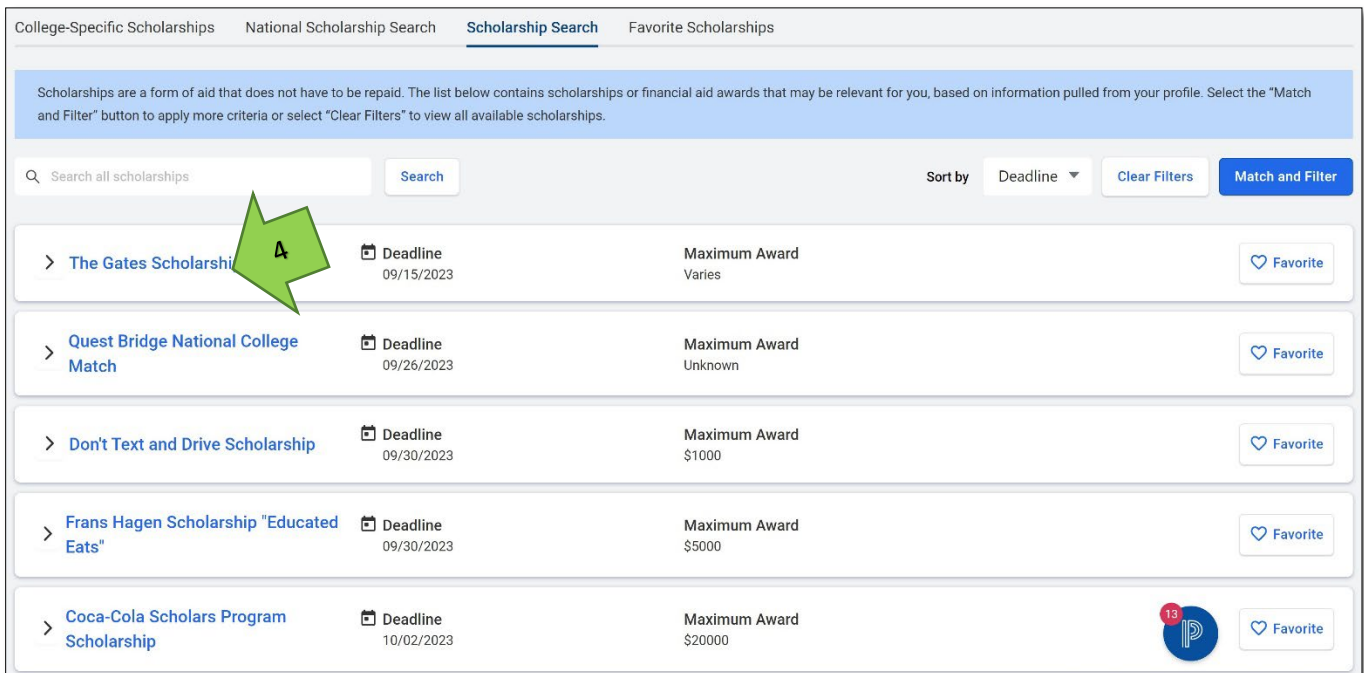
